


Preschool Enrollment





A high-quality, Catholic education just became even more *Affordable*!

State Scholarships by the Numbers

- 11 of 203 are receiving Jon Peterson Scholarship (5.4%)
 185 of 203 have been awarded EdChoice Expansion & Cleveland Scholarship (91.1%)
- 7 of 203 are not receiving a scholarship (3.4%) these have chosen not to participate or are in process of getting awarded
- 89 students (43.8%) are receiving \$6,166.00 (highest scholarship) 35 students (17.2%) are receiving \$616.60 (lowest scholarship) 61 students (30%) are receiving something between \$6,166 and \$616.60
- \$727,167 EdChoice Expansion & Cleveland Scholarship expected in 25/26 \$698,079 EdChoice Expansion & Cleveland Scholarship received in 24/25 \$407,877 EdChoice Expansion & Cleveland Scholarship received in 23/24

EdChoice

Facts...

- Our Catholic school funding via EdChoice was not at the expense of public education
- Public education saw even more significant increases in funding in the recent budget than Catholic education.
- Public Schools will also benefit from recent home appraisals and the significant increases in home values and thus taxes benefits benefitting public schools.

What does this mean for us?

- Increased affordability for all families desiring a
 Catholic education at Assumption
- Continued investment to the highest quality education possible
- Rise in tuition = greatest possible benefit from the EdChoice Scholarship.
- Closing the GAP between true cost to educate and what we collect per student






