

2021-2022 Options for Faith Formation

KinderFaith - Pre-K (4 years old) & Kindergarten

Sundays during 9:30am Mass

Children will come downstairs for the readings & then RETURN to Mass after they have completed the Liturgy of the Word.

Please fill out the registration form so we have information on your child, but NO registration fee is needed for this age group.

Discover, Finding Faith in Life - For children in grades 1 – 3 only

Sunday mornings beginning on 9/19/21 *Schedule of class dates will be given on the first day.*

Parents will bring their child to 9:30am Mass and during the introductory rite, Father will call the children forward, give them a blessing, and send them off with their catechists to share our Catholic faith using the Catholic Children's Bible.

Children will NOT return to Mass, parents should remain in the church and the catechists will bring the children upstairs to the church at 10:30am.

Saturday Mornings from 9 - 10:15am – For children in Grades 1 - 8

Begins 9/18/21 Schedule of class dates will be given on the first day.

Meets weekly September – April follows the school calendar with holiday breaks.

Sunday Mornings from 10:35 – 12pm – For teenagers in Grades 9 - 10

Begins on 9/19/21

Schedules with class dates will be handed out at the first class.

Intergenerational Family Faith Formation for Grade 1 - Adult

Our first session on Sunday, October 3rd will begin with a Family Celebration Mass at 11:30am.

Following Mass, we will continue with our Faith Formation session until 2:30pm.

Please note: This year, we will NOT have a meal at our sessions. Sessions will include large group and children will break into age appropriate groups. This is a 3-hour commitment once a month from October through April on a Sunday afternoon.

Dates: Oct 3, Nov 7, Dec 5, Jan 9, Feb 6, Mar 6, and Apr 3

Because there are only 7 sessions for the year, attendance at each session is crucial. If you have conflicts on a regular basis with these dates, please choose another Faith Formation Option for your family.

Sacraments

Sacramental formation for Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation will be done separately from the faith formation classes. Information on sacramental formation will be given out at a parent meeting at a later date to families that are directly involved.
