

**HOLY FAMILY PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION
CODE OF CONDUCT
FAMILY AGREEMENT**

The Holy Family Religious Education program is a faith-based educational program. We are teaching children about being more like Jesus in their everyday lives. We expect all of the children in attendance to behave in a respectful, courteous and kind manner. If inappropriate behavior occurs, the following will be implemented:

First Offense: An appropriate warning will be issued and the incident will be documented into the behavior log. A note will be mailed home stating the behavior issue. This note must be signed and returned when the student returns the following week.

Second offense: The student will be sent to the office and a conference with the Religious Education Director will occur. A letter will be mailed home to inform the family of the student's misconduct. The students will be shown his/her Code of Conduct contract and will sign and date it again. The student should apologize to the Catechist and/or the class before returning to his/her seat.

Third Offense: The student will be sent to the office where the family or emergency contact person will be called to pick up the child. A meeting with the Religious Education Director will be necessary to discuss further action. **One such option would be that the parent/guardian accompanies the student to his/her Religious Education class sessions for the remainder of the year.**

Please review the *Code of Conduct* and the entire contents of the *Religious Education Family Handbook* with your child/ren. List the name(s) of your children below, the grade level, the day attending class, and sign and date this form. Return it with your youngest child to his/her Religious Education class by the *second class session*.
