

Saint Project Guidelines

Choosing your confirmation name is something you should take seriously. At your Baptism you received your name in the Church. Some people will choose to use their name during the sacrament of Confirmation as a continuation of their baptism. It is also acceptable to take a new name of another saint who has lived a life that you desire to emulate. You could choose to take the name of a saint that you admire, or perhaps you choose your name after a person that emulates Christ. You can choose a saint name because they are the patron of a cause or activity that is important to you, or perhaps you have a connection with their feast day.

Research different saints and choose a saint name that you will take at Confirmation. If you are lost, try looking at www.Catholic.org for some suggestions.

Ideas for something other than a typed paper:

- Video/Vlog
- Art project (canvas, drawing, etc.)
- Power Point
- Photography

If you choose to write a report following the instructions below:

- Name of the saint you chose
- Why you chose that saint
- Tell us a little about the saint's life – where did they live, how did they die, why are they a saint
- Include any special information about that saint that interests you – what they are the patron of, when their feast day is, did they perform miracles

The report is to be 1-2 pages long. It can be written or typed.
