1. *Walking Away*, 1997 by Meryl Taradash. Rotating aluminum within painted steel frame.
2. *TAU*, by S. Orange native Tony Smith. Fabricated and installed in Meadowland Park in 2008, as a gift to the town by his wife, Jane.
3. *Rain Park*, Designed, built & maintained by Chambers Design in partnership with S. Orange Green Team and S. Orange Environmental Commission. Funded by American Water.
4. *Gateway Murals*, 2014 (behind 9 West S.O. Ave) These colorful S. Orange themed murals decorate the NJ Transit retaining wall.
5. The Herb & Milly Iris Gallery within SOPAC hosts 2-3 art exhibits a year, featuring opening receptions and artist talks. Hours: Mon.-Sat. 10 a.m. -6 p.m. and two hours before performances.
6. *The Music Walk*, funded by a 2019 grant from the Main Street New Jersey program, combines music and murals for all ages to enjoy.

7. *Spiotta Park Murals* and Musical Animals, 2018 & 2019 by Dan Fenelon. Pierro Outdoors, and SOVCA.

8. *Valley Street Windows - View of Steel and Flowers*, 2019 by Patricia Cazorla and Nancy Saleme. Pierro Outdoors, New Jersey State Council on the Arts

9. *Village Hallways* rotates displays by local artists at the S. Orange Village offices (76 S.Orange Ave, 3rd fl.) Mon-Fri, 9 am - 4pm.

10. *Post Office Mural*, 1939 by Bernard Perlin. This untitled “family scene” was Perlin’s first significant commission. [Post office murals](#) were commissioned by the [US Department of the Treasury](#) between 1934-1943 to secure art for public buildings that met high artistic standards, was accessible to all and to boost the morale of the American people suffering from the effects of [the Depression](#).
