### **Criteria to be eligible for Housing services:**

- Homeless and/or unsafe and/ or inappropriately housed.
- Low or limited income.
- Function independently.
- Benefit from support services of advocacy and case management offered by staff.

### **Description of this agency's role in helping people with housing:**

- Talk with anyone who has contacted us looking for housing or housing information and available programs in this area.
- Discuss appropriate options with individual.
- Provide application for housing, when appropriate.
- Provide referrals for appropriate agencies if we are unable to serve the individual.
- If an individual is currently in SRO housing with us and would like to move to an apartment situation, we again provide referrals and/ or advocacy.

### **Steps to follow in accessing CCHO housing assistance:**

- Housing assistance in the form of referral/information can be done by contacting the Housing Staff at 607-436-9250.
- Fill out and submit an application (This can be done at the Housing Office at 52 Maple or Catholic Charities of Delaware, Otsego and Schoharie Counties at 176 Main Street. Catholic Charities of Delaware, Otsego and Schoharie Counties do not provide housing, but they accept applications on our behalf.

### **Other services offered by the local CC agency:**

- Community Mediation, Dispute Resolution
- Child Care Support
- Emergency Assistance/ Community Connections

- Drug Court Case Management
- Victim's Impact Panel/Alternatives to Incarceration
- Community Maternity Services

Most of the local Catholic Charities programs have eligibility guidelines which relate to referral directly from DSS, Drug Treatment Court, Court Ordered Parenting Education, Residence in our Low-Income SRO Housing (through Catholic Charities Housing Office); support services and provision of or use of Child Care. Other Services like Dispute Resolution and Emergency Assistance and Referral are free and available to the public
