





St. Anthony Church Project Update

With permission from the diocese, St. Anthony's has accepted a proposal from Kostreba Tuckpointing and Roofing out of Rice, MN in the amount of \$26,860. This fee will include necessary tuckpointing and cleaning of the foundation and upper stones. They will begin this work in September. Plans for the sacristy roof are still pending and will be the next matter of attention. Also, pending diocesan approvals, and needed funds, we have a very tentative start date for the interior part of the church project for spring of 2027. Please continue to pray for this project.

Eucharistic For the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass, you may have noticed that the priest has several choices. Eucharistic Prayer I was the only one used from 1570-1970. It has different parts that can be added in on Feast days such as on Christmas, Holy Thursday, Pentecost, and others. It lists Mary, Joseph, the Apostles and the Martyrs. Eucharistic Prayer II is the oldest and one of the shortest. (Its brevity makes it some people's

Since 1970, post-Vatican II, many other Eucharistic Prayers options have been added to the Roman Missal. Eucharistic Prayer III particularly mentions the Holy Spirit and has a place for inserting the name of the saint of the day. Eucharistic Prayer IV is like a summary of salvation history. In most of the Eucharistic Prayers the local bishop (Bishop Chad for our diocese) and Pope Leo are remembered. The Roman Missal also includes two Eucharistic Prayers for Reconciliation, typically chosen during the Lenten season. There are four Eucharistic Prayers for Various Needs
