

PASTOR'S LETTER

We will have a Blessing service Sunday, Nov. 2nd at 2pm at St. Gertrude's Cemetery Memorial Area followed by a gathering at the Threshers with a light snack and visiting.

Our parishes will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS), next weekend, a collection approved by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops to be taken every three years. The AMS provides pastoral care to Catholic men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or who work for the federal government beyond U.S. borders - including those from our own parish and diocese. The AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment. As of the time of writing this, it is expected that SNAP benefits will not be available because of the government shutdown. We encourage gifts to our Meeker Area Food Shelf. Of course, non-perishable food is welcome, but so are financial gifts. Food shelves can buy more food with every dollar than we can. You may make out a check to your parish with "Food Shelf" on the bottom, and we will get it there.



Revival "At the end of the Eucharistic Prayer, the Priest takes the paten with the conse-

crated Host and the sacred Chalice in his ordained hands. He elevates them both while pronouncing the DOXOLOGY. "Through Him, and with Him, and in Him, O God, Almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is Yours for ever and ever." "AMEN" the people acclaim! The Priest places the paten and Chalice back on the corporal cloth." (GIRM150)

The DOXOLOGY, which concludes the Eucharistic Prayer, gives praise to God the Father through His Son, Jesus Christ, and in union with the Holy Spirit. The assembled faithful affirm their belief in the Holy Eucharist with their great "AMEN!" This is the most significant "AMEN" acclamation of the entire Mass. The assembly's "AMEN" signifies "their agreement with what has been said." (CCC AMEN)

Recall the major parts of the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass from the Preface through the Doxology.
