



OCIA, the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, is the process by which our Catholic Church prepares adults for the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. This includes Catholic adults who never received these sacraments in their younger years, or adults who are non-Catholics and wish to learn more about and better understand the beliefs of the Catholic Church. The OCIA process for unbaptized children, age 7-17 who want to enter into the Catholic Church is very similar to the adult process. "The Body of Christ "AMEN!

After the bread and wine have been become the Body and the Blood of Christ at the Consecration, the priest reverently raises the Host and the Chalice. A bell may be rung at the Elevation. The General Instructions of the Roman Missal 150 state: "A little before the Consecration, (at the Epiclesis), a minister rings a small bell as a signal to the faithful. The minister also rings the small bell at each elevation by the Priest, according to local custom." The Elevation is a sacred moment of Prayer and Adoration. Gaze upon Jesus, truly, humbly, with you in the Consecrated Bread and Wine. In your own words or in a memorized prayer, adore Jesus for all He has done for you. Praise Him for being present at this Heavenly Banquet. Thank Him for His Sacrifice on the Cross bearing the burden of your sins so you could be forgiven. Love Him for remaining with you in the Blessed Sacrament. Or pray - as parents and teachers have been instructing children since the Apostle St. Thomas first declared it to the Risen Christ - "My Lord and my God."
