This weekend we are blessed to be hosting a priest representing Cross Catholic Outreach. This official Catholic ministry was founded to link parishes in the U.S. with priests, religious brothers and sisters, and laypeople working in Church missions overseas. News ALERT

Protect Reproductive Options (PRO) Act [H.F. 1]
passes Minnesota House Committee
This is an extreme abortion bill.

The Minnesota Catholic Conference states the following:

Abortion advocates have won a narrow majority in the Minnesota legislature. Now some state lawmakers want to pass bills that would:

- Create a new law (or constitutional amendment) allowing the abortion of any unborn baby, for any reason and done any time until birth;
- Establish that Minnesota law gives parents no right at all to know if their minor daughter is undergoing an abortion, even though parental consent is required for all other medical procedures;
- Establish in law a requirement that even those with deeply held pro-life convictions must pay for the killing of the unborn with their tax dollars

Only 7 countries in the world have an abortion law so extreme, among them China and North Korea.
