

PASTOR'S LETTER

We have a Holy Day of Obligation on Wednesday, All Saints. We have six Masses, so we hope you can make one of them.

Please note that Tuesday, Thursday and Friday Mass schedules are different than normal. Bishop Chad is coming to celebrate Mass on All Souls Day at St. Philip at 8:30 am, and everyone is welcome. Because of that, St. John's daily Mass will be on Friday instead, and there will not be an 8:30 am Mass at St. Philip on Friday.

With Thanksgiving approaching, we will be collecting food and money for our Food Shelf. Please remember that the Food Shelf can buy \$4 worth of food for every \$1 we donate.

With the advice of our AFC Pastoral Council, we will be reviving Communion under both forms at both St. John and Our Lady starting Nov. 5th. We need more Eucharistic Ministers to begin at St. Philip and St. Anthony. Our church teaches "Holy Communion has a fuller form as a sign when it takes place under both kinds. For in this form the sign of the Eucharistic banquet is more clearly evident and clearer expression is given to the divine will by which the new and eternal Covenant is ratified in the Blood of the Lord, as also the connection between the Eucharistic banquet and the eschatological banquet in the Kingdom of the Father.


