

Letter sent to former members of St. Gertrude, Forest City

We want to update everyone about what is happening with the buildings of St. Gertrude at Forest City. Since merging with the Church of St. Philip in 2017, the administrative council has studied numerous options for what to do with St. Gertrude. This spring, the council decided to have a controlled burn of the church and a meeting was held with former parishioners. Upon hearing opposition to this plan, bids were obtained to take the church down and to remove its basement. At the September meeting, the council approved a bid proposal by Toutges Brothers. Prior to the church being taken down, an asbestos inspection must occur, and once it is completed, demolition can proceed. The results of the inspection could affect the timing of the removal of the church this fall. Once it has been removed, the rectory and empty church lot will be put up for sale, likely next year. Minor repairs and clean up of the house and grounds will occur prior to placing them on the market. Funds obtained from the sale will be placed within the St. Gertrude Cemetery Perpetual Care Funds.

There will be a Memory Garden designed and placed in St. Gertrude's Cemetery sometime next year. It will be a low maintenance design on a cement slab. (Shaw Bench, Annv. Rock, Metal Crucifix, Bell and possibly other items).

The Stained Glass windows are being saved and sold to parishioners. There is a cost to remove the window if you want the whole window plus free will donation. \*\* We have someone who will make a smaller item with pieces of the stained glass windows. Any inquiry on windows let Bruce or Mary
