PASTOR'S LETTER

This Sunday is Commitment Sunday for the 2023 Diocesan Ministries Appeal. Watching the video at mass, we are reminded of the good work the DMA is doing through important ministries that parishes are not able to provide on their own. Remember, in supporting the DMA, we contribute to those important ministries in the diocese, but we also support the project we have identified for our parish - St. Philip—Outdoor Youth Area; St. Anthony—Capital Campaign; St. John—Education Center new outside doors and new TV and mount in church; Our Lady—Tuition for Our Lady students attending the School of St. Philip.

As you reflect on what your pledge should be, prayerfully keep in mind God's generosity to you. This year's theme, "One in Christ," reminds us that we are called to communion as a diocesan family. He also invites us into his mission – to share our gifts to bring hope to others. Be assured that contributions to the DMA will be used only for the benefit of the ministries designated in the brochure and no other purpose. As introduced at the completion of today's Mass, the Church Interior Committee, on behalf of St. Anthony's Capital Campaign, has organized an additional opportunity for parish families to provide feedback specific to the plans to renovate the interior of our Church. While the continuing priority is to complete the Church's exterior improvements before the interior, it's important to finalize the plans for the total project. If you would like your family's feedback to be included in these decisions, we are providing an opportunity for you to complete a feedback form. The forms are available in the parish center next to the new rendering pictures. If you want your feedback to be included in the final design decision, return your form on or before Sunday, December 10.

We are glad to have returned to Communion under both forms at St. John, Our Lady, and St. Philip. Thanks to all who have said yes to this ministry recently. We still need more Eucharistic ministers at St. Anthony. Please contact Jessie in the office or one of us priests to offer your help.

Please be generous in the Catholic Campaign for Human Development collection. In the U.S., more than 11% of the population lives in poverty.
