

PASTOR'S LETTER

Advent begins next weekend. It is a short period of preparation for the celebration of Christmas. Because there are only three Wednesdays in Advent this year, we are beginning Reconciliation this Wednesday evening. And our first Sunday service is already Dec. 3 at 4pm. Please see the full Reconciliation schedule in this bulletin.

Once again, everyone in our AFC is invited to the celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe at St. Philip Sunday, Dec. 10 with a Noon Mass in Spanish, and a bilingual homily. We will have a Mariachi Band for Mass and to play at the Potluck meal following in the Social Hall.

Thank you for your generosity to the 2023 DMA. We saw in the video last week the impact of our contribution on real people right here in our diocese. By joining with others around the diocese in support of these ministries, we can help those in need and support programs for youth and adults who need our prayers and assistance. If you haven't made your pledge or given a gift, please consider making your contribution now. You may return your pledge in the collection basket or simply drop it in the mail. You may also make your pledge or gift online at https://www.dnu.org/dma/. Remember that your gift also supports our parish project: St. Philip—Outdoor Youth Area; St. Anthony—Capital Campaign; St. John—Education Center new outside doors and new TV and mount in church; Our Lady—Tuition for Our Lady students attending the School of St. Philip. Be assured that your gift will only be used to support those ministries designated in the DMA brochure and no other.

The Church Interior Committee, on behalf of St. Anthony's Capital Campaign, has organized an additional opportunity for parish families to provide feedback specific to the plans to renovate the interior of our Church. While the continuing priority is to complete the Church's exterior improvements before the interior, it's important to finalize the plans for the total project. If you would like your family's feedback to be included in these decisions, we are providing an opportunity for you to complete a feedback form. The forms are available in the parish center next to the new rendering pictures. If you want your feedback to be included in the final design decision, return your form on or before Sunday, December 10.

We are glad to have returned to Communion under both forms at St. John, Our Lady, and St. Philip. We still need more Eucharistic ministers at St. Anthony. Please contact Jessie in the office or one of us priests to offer your help.


