

It is time to give an update on how our parishes are doing in meeting the goals our Diocese has given us for the DMA. St. Philip's goal is \$43,325. We are at \$21,430. St. Anthony's goal is \$20,300. We are at \$4,500. St. John's goal is \$18,072. We are at \$18,799. Our Lady's goal is \$12,502. We are at \$6,325. Thank you to all who have given to the Diocesan Ministries Appeal. Your contributions to the DMA reach individuals and families across the diocese. If you have not had the opportunity to make your pledge or gift yet, envelopes are available in the back of church. You may return your pledge in the collection basket or simply drop it in the mail. You may also make your pledge or gift online at https:// www.dnu.org/dma/. Either way, your gift will be counted toward our parish goal. Be assured that your gift will only be used to support those ministries designated in the DMA brochure - ministries that are vital to our diocesan church - as well as our own parish project: St. Philip—Outdoor Youth Area; St. Anthony— Capital Campaign; St. John—Education Center new outside doors and new TV and mount in church; Our Lady—Tuition for Our Lady students attending the School of St. Philip.

St. Gertrude's is planning on creating a memorial area at the entrance to the cemetery where the church bell, the bench, large rock, and outdoor crucifix that had been in the front of church will be placed. We hope that this will help all those who miss the church.



"The Body of Christ "AMEN!

In Old Testament times wine was consumed commonly because the sanitation of water was unreliable. It was also used in celebrations. Wine symbolized God's abundant blessings. As Psalm 104 states: "You bring bread from the earth and wine to gladden our hearts." Even yet today in Jewish homes, four servings of wine are consumed at the Passover. The "cup of blessing at the end of the Jewish Passover meal adds to the festive joy of wine, an eschatological dimension:" referring to the last sobering things - death, judgment, the resurrection of the body, heaven, purgatory, hell.
