

PASTOR'S LETTER

The Advent Reconciliation schedule in this bulletin.

We have a Holy Day of Obligation this week, The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Vigil Masses will be Thursday evening followed by Friday Masses.

Everyone is invited to our first AFC Encounter Night as part of the Eucharistic Revival. On Friday, there will be a Potluck meal from 6-7pm at St. John with Adoration and Reconciliation from 7-8pm.

Once again, everyone in our AFC is invited to the celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe at St. Philip Sunday, Dec. 10 with a Noon Mass in Spanish, and a bilingual homily. We will have a Mariachi Band for Mass and to play at the Potluck meal following in the Social Hall.

Thank you to all who have given to the Diocesan Ministries Appeal. Your contributions to the DMA reach individuals and families across the diocese, providing family and crisis counseling, emergency assistance, religious and spiritual formation, and supporting our seminarians. If you have not had the opportunity to make your pledge or gift yet, envelopes are available in the back of church. You may return your pledge in the collection basket or simply drop it in the mail. Be assured that your gift will only be used to support those ministries designated in the DMA brochure - ministries that are vital to our diocesan church - as well as our own parish project: St. Philip—Outdoor Youth Area; St. Anthony—Capital Campaign; St. John—Education Center new outside doors and new TV and mount in church; Our Lady—Tuition for Our Lady students attending the School of St. Philip.

The Church Interior Committee, on behalf of St. Anthony's Capital Campaign, has organized an additional opportunity for parish families to provide feedback specific to the plans to renovate the interior of our Church. While the continuing priority is to complete the Church's exterior improvements before the interior, it's important to finalize the plans for the total project. If you would like your family's feedback to be included in these decisions, we are providing an opportunity for you to complete a feedback form. The forms are available in the parish center next to the new rendering pictures. If you want your feedback to be included in the final design decision, return your form on or before Sunday, December 10.


