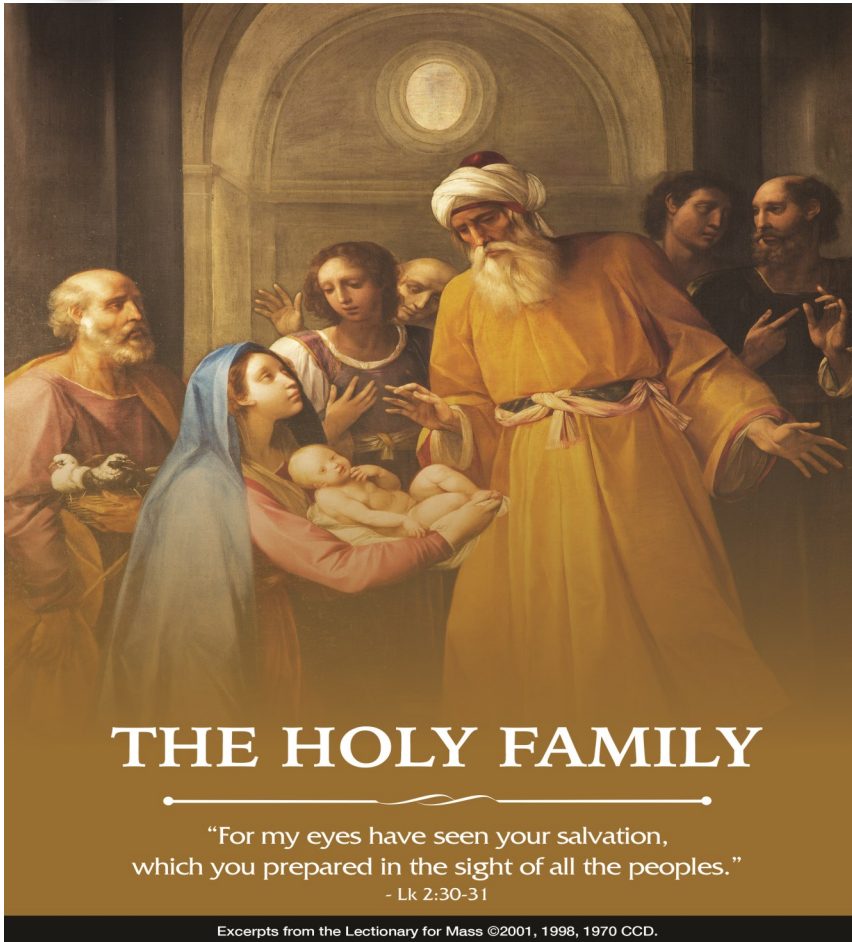

Happy New Year to everyone! Because the Solemnity of Mary, The Holy Mother of God falls on a Monday (Jan. 1) this year, there is no obligation to attend Mass, but we offer two Masses for those who would like to celebrate this wonderful feast.

Please put the next Encounter Night of Adoration and Reconciliation on your calendar—January 12th at St. Anthony from 7-8pm with refreshments to follow.

An update on how our parishes are doing in meeting the goals our Diocese has given us for the DMA: St. Philip's goal is \$43,325. We are at \$25,924. St. Anthony's goal is \$20,300. We are at \$8,865. St. John's goal is \$18,072. We are at \$22,694. Our Lady's goal is \$12,502. We are at \$8,215. Thank you to all who have given to the Diocesan Ministries Appeal. Your contributions to the DMA reach individuals and families across the diocese. If you have not had the opportunity to make your pledge or gift yet, envelopes are available in the back of church. You may return your pledge in the collection basket or simply drop it in the mail. You may also make your pledge or gift online at <https://www.dnu.org/dma/>. Either way, your gift will be counted toward our parish goal. Be assured that your gift will only be used to support those ministries designated in the DMA brochure - ministries that are vital to our diocesan church - as well as our own parish project: St. Philip—Outdoor Youth Area; St. Anthony—Capital Campaign; St. John—Education Center new outside doors and new TV and mount in church; Our Lady—Tuition for Our Lady students attending the School of St. Philip.

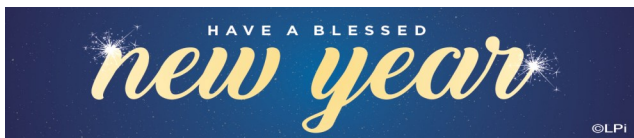

The Baby Jesus, "the Bread of Life", was found "wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger." In the 5th century St. Cyril of Alexandria explained, "The setting of Christ's birth points us to the Eucharist. Since through sin man becomes like the beasts, Christ lies in the trough where animals feed, offering them, not hay, but His own Body as life-giving Bread." The manger foreshadows the Holy Eucharist when Jesus Himself becomes food for humanity. As you gaze at the Nativity scene this Christmas, dwell upon the beautiful gift of the Holy Eucharist.

St. Anthony Church Project Update

As we continue to focus on the repair of our church roof and the exterior of our renovation project, the Church Interior committee would like to thank all who participated in the church interior rendering feedback. This feedback will be used to guide the interior renovation phase **after the roof and tuck-pointing projects are completed.**

The roof of our church is in poor shape and deteriorating rapidly. We encourage everyone to submit a pledge form or make a donation to the roof project soon. Pledge forms are located next to the church rendering sample in the parish center. All funds collected are being **prioritized to the roof project** so that it can be completed as soon as possible.

Here are the tally results of the church interior feedback forms received:

Rendering #1: 27%
Rendering #2: 73%

Latin: 20%
English: 74%
No Preference: 6%

New Furniture: 36%
Current Furniture: 53%
No Preference: 11%
