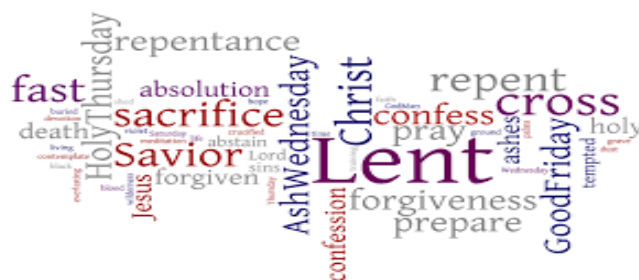
We encourage every family to participate in this year's Operation Rice Bowl Campaign to help feed the needy of the world.
