

A Note from Fr. Jeff Horejsi

This weekend we take up The Catholic Relief Services Collection to reveal Christ's love to our brothers and sisters in need. This collection helps six Catholic agencies to provide relief and support for struggling communities and to work for peace and reconciliation among our marginalized brothers and sisters here and around the world. Please prayerfully consider how you can support the collection. Learn more about the collection at www.usccb. org/catholic-relief.

Next weekend our AFC Social Concerns Committee will offer the opportunity to easily advocate for hungry people in our country and abroad. We will be using a letter from Bread for the World to encourage our federal legislators to increase access to fresh fruits and vegetables and remove barriers to SNAP for marginalized populations, keep food out of landfills, and support funding for international food aid programs such as Food for Peace. The letter can also be emailed by going to www.bread.org and under "Act" go to "Advocate."

We have Rice Bowls available again this Lent. In addition, we are participating in Cross Catholic's "Wells of Salvation" project. The hand-pump wells are simple but effective. 
Believe it. Achieve it!


