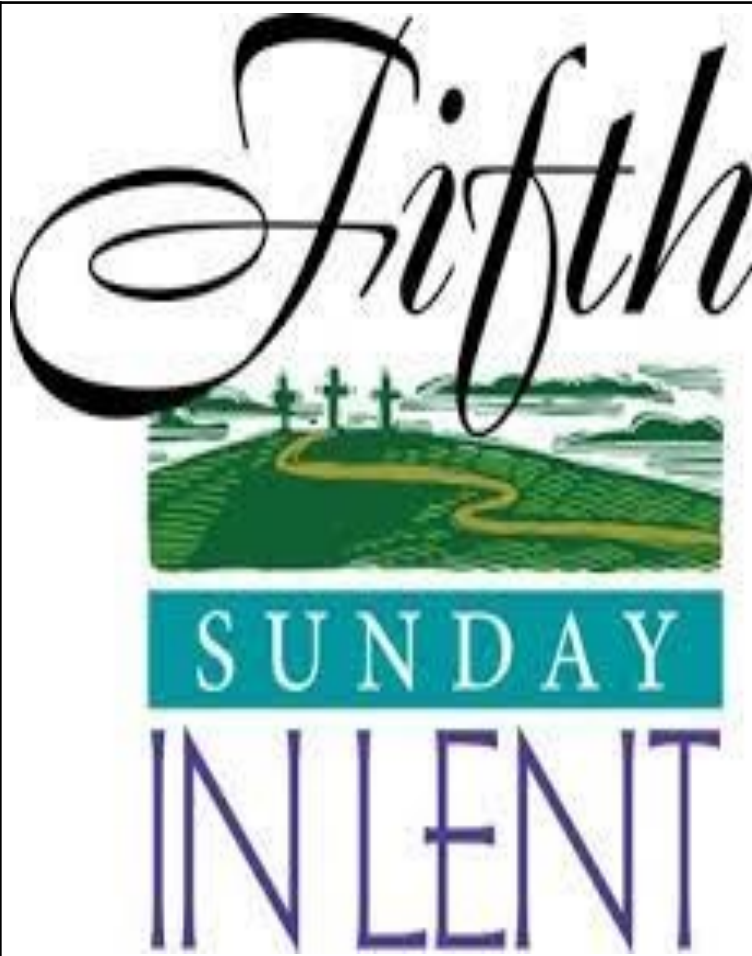

Greetings from the School of St. Philip!

When you hear the word "manipulative", what's the first thing that comes to mind? For many, it is the negative connotation of the word, someone who is manipulative or manipulating, someone working to control another person. Simply adding a "s" at the end and making the word "manipulatives" creates a whole new meaning. Manipulatives are mostly used in math, for example Unifix cubes or shape pieces. But the definition as a whole is that manipulatives are concrete items that students can use in the classroom to help solidify a concept or idea. We use manipulatives in music class such as the photo of Easter eggs with notes and rhythms, or in reading with stations activities. Many times, manipulatives are color coded as well. What kinds of concrete objects do you use in your day to day to help with things? Do you use color coding at all in your daily life? Maybe with your planner, you use one color to mark family events and a different color to mark work events. Or you have colored magnets or clips on a chores chart for each child. No matter our age, the things we learn in our school years continue on throughout our lives. Whether ideas and ways of organizing and learning are passed on from our parents and grandparents, from our teachers in school, or a mixture of both, our educational background is hugely important in our growth and success as adults. How do you pass on knowledge between generations in your family? How do you solidify schoolwork at home and share the importance of education with your children/grandchildren/nieces and nephews/etc.? Do you have any tricks you use in your daily life that may have actually started in an elementary math class? Education is so incredibly important, and it is constantly evolving. We are thankful for all your support to our school as we continue to learn and grow each day!
