Greetings from the School of St. Philip!

Our students have been praying the Stations of the Cross each Monday during Lent. This week, we concluded our final Monday of Lent with singing the Stations of the Cross as a photo of each station was held up. There are multiple ways you can move through the stations in a prayerful manner. Some ways that the students prayed the stations besides singing was walking the stations and reading a passage about each one and then reciting Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be. We walked the stations and made connections to our current world with each station with a time for silent, personal prayer at each one. One week, students took turns reading a prayer for each station and then brought an activity back to their classrooms to do.

Actively participating in various ways of prayer and worship is just one of the many aspects of religion the students at the School of St. Philip are enriched with. St Therese of Lisieux said, "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy." Further, the *Catechism* describes prayer as a "vital and personal relationship with the living and true God." Personal relationship...what does your relationship with God look like? It will be different for everyone, but that's part of what makes it so special, is we all have our own unique relationship with God, with prayer, and with our worship. A friend recently shared this with me - "Jesus died for you in *public*. Don't live for him in *private*."

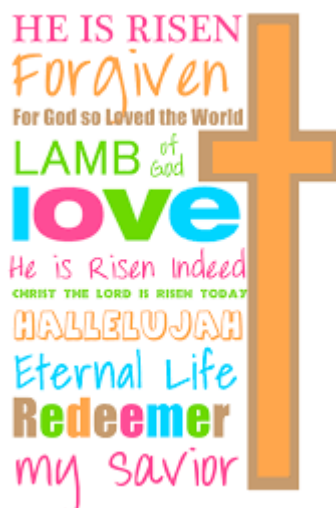
