



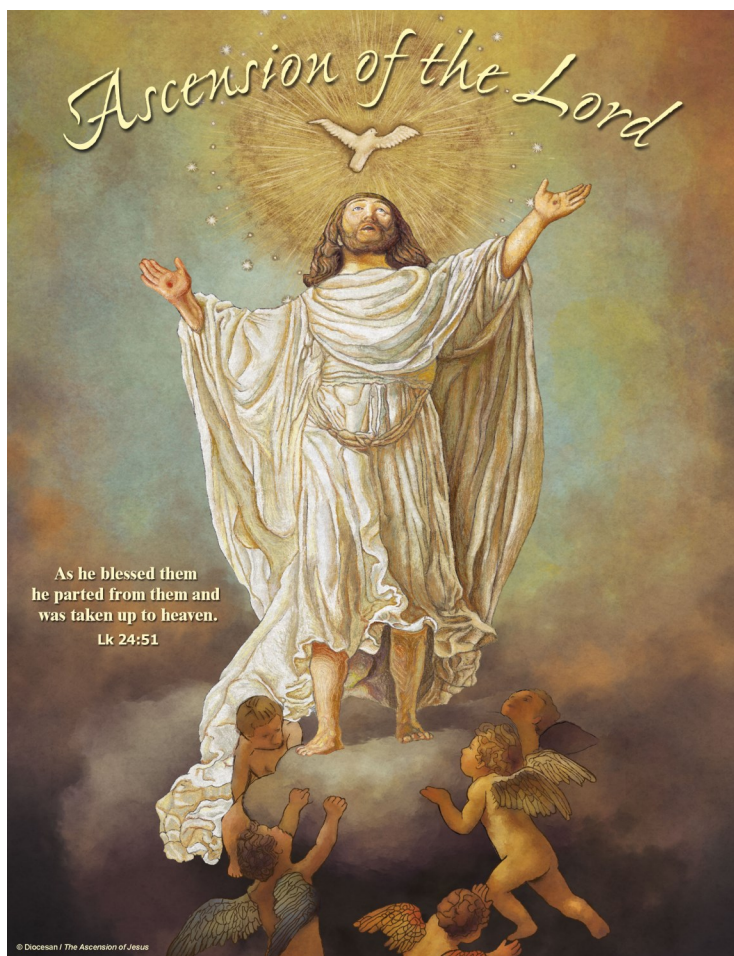

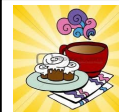

This is My Body Eucharistic Congress 2023

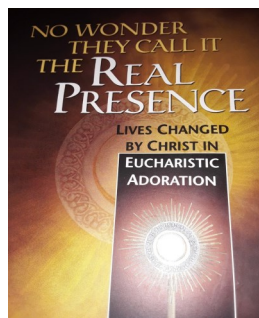
Come and join thousands of Catholics as we Rejoice in the Lord through the Eucharist!

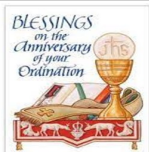

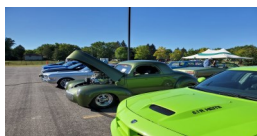
