



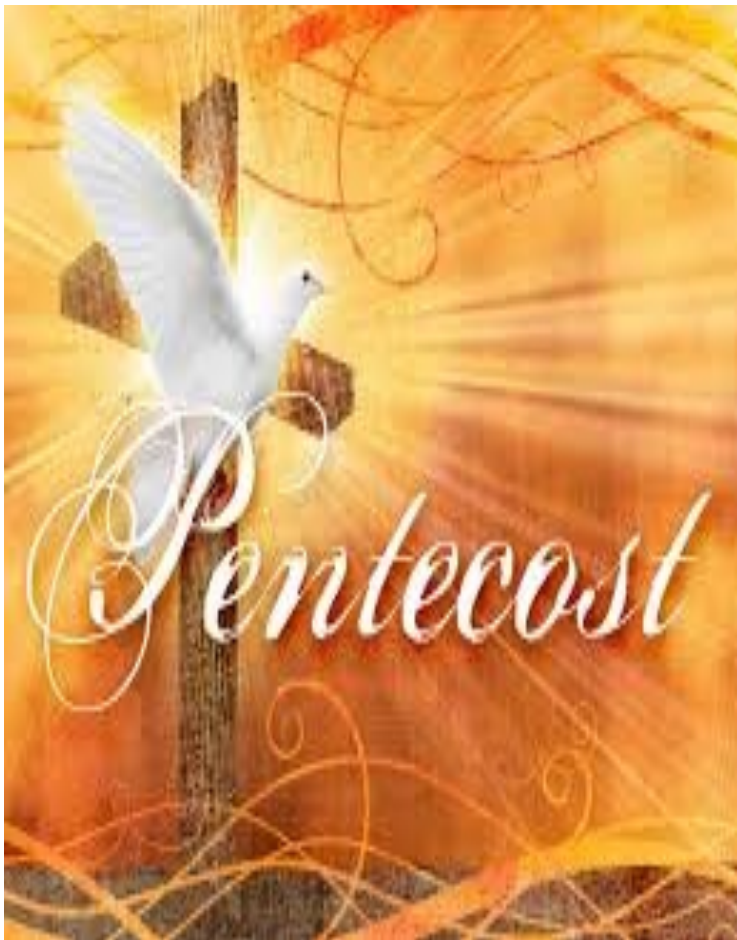

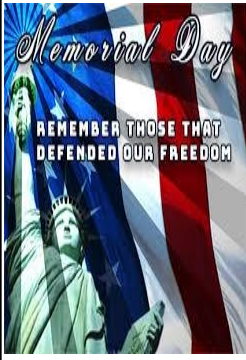

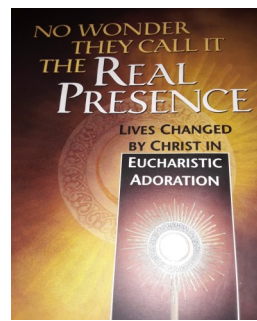
### **This is My Body Eucharistic Congress 2023**
