

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is a several month process by which our Church prepares adults for Baptism and the other Sacraments of Initiation - Confirmation and Holy Communion. It is a learning and loving process in which conversion of the heart brings one to Jesus Christ. Also, through weekly meetings, those attending gain a deeper appreciation and understanding of the Catholic beliefs and practices. The RCIA journey begins in the fall, and the process becomes more intense during Lent as candidates prepare for receiving their sacraments at the Easter Vigil. After Easter, we continue to meet and talk about living out our faith.
