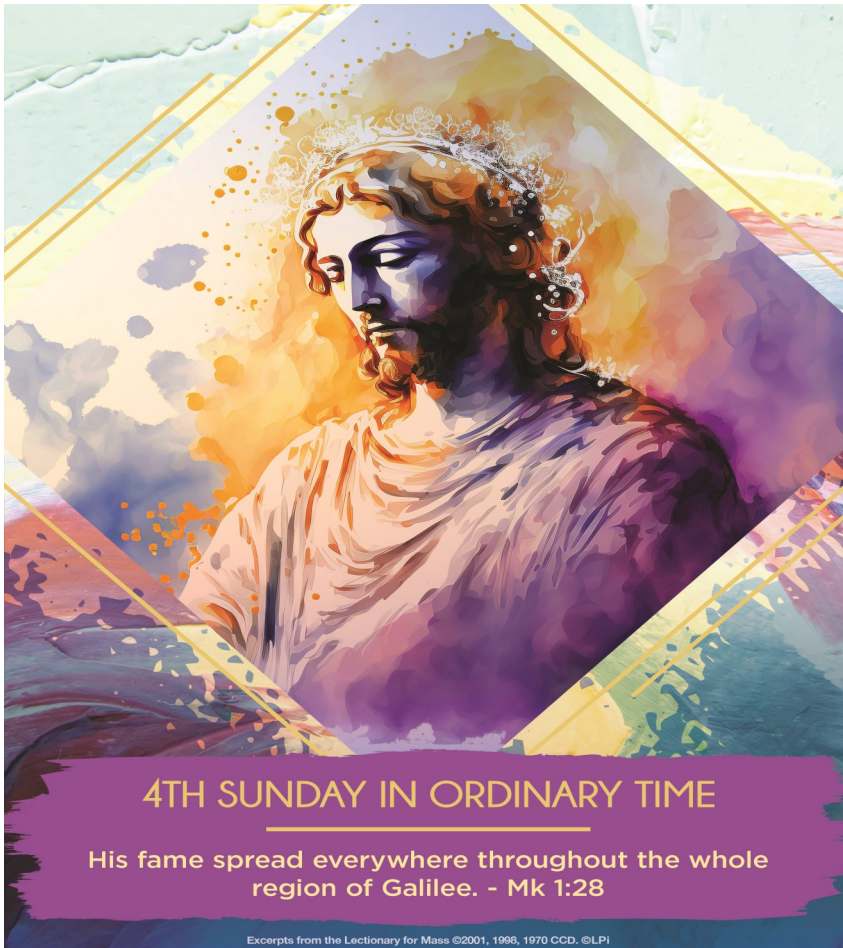

"The Body of Christ" AMEN!

The Code of Canon Law of the Catholic Church 924 states: "The most holy Eucharistic sacrifice must be offered with bread and with wine in which a little water must be mixed. The bread must be only wheat and recently made so that there is no danger of spoiling. The wine must be natural from the fruit of the vine and not spoiled." In addition, Canon Law 926 writes: "In the Eucharistic celebration, in accordance with the ancient tradition of the Latin Church, the priest is to use unleavened bread wherever he celebrates Mass."

Receiving the Body of Christ under the appearance of bread in "the Eucharist is the sum and summary of our Catholic faith". What about someone with celiac disease?
