Advent is a gift to us to prepare ourselves to celebrate the great feast of Christmas, one of our most holy days of the Church year. During Advent we contemplate the Second Coming of Jesus at the end of time. What needs to change in our life to be ready? Christ comes to us each day and especially at Christmas. I encourage you to prepare for welcoming Christ by celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The schedule for the two Sunday and four Wednesday evening communal penance services is also included. We also offer the sacrament 45 minutes before the Saturday evening liturgy.

Masses for the Holy Day of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be Dec. 8th. In the past when this Solemnity has fallen on Monday or Saturday, there has not be an obligation. However it has been re-evaluated, and because it is our national patroness' feast day it remains an obligation.

Everyone is invited to the celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe on Sunday, Dec. 14th at the Noon Mass in Spanish at St. Philip. The homily will also be in English. We are planning to have a Mariachi band for Mass and to play during the Potluck meal to follow in the Social Hall. Following the Mass, we are planning to have some youth dance in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

The Jubilee Year of Hope closing Mass will be Sunday, December 28th at 10am at the Cathedral in New Ulm.

The Holy Day of Obligation for Mary, Mother of God will have Masses Dec. 31st and Jan. 1st.


