We have already come to the end of our first quarter of learning. Report cards will go out this week and we will have parent-student-teacher conferences on Tuesday and Thursday this week. We believe strongly in the partnership between families and school staff for the benefit of the students. Taking time to sit down and discuss the student's progress and goals is an important part of the learning process, so these are important days and meetings.

I was able to attend the MNSAA accreditation association conference last week. As we work through our self-study process, the conference provided beneficial workshops that will assist us in preparing for our site visit in the fall of 2019. Every seven years our school goes through this process that challenges us to reflect on and demonstrate the ways that we exemplify our school's mission. We have seven standards to meet which include (1) mission and philosophy, (2) teaching and learning, (3) climate for learning, (4) communication and community relations, (5) personnel, (6) leadership, administration, and governance, and (7)the school strategic plan for improvement. Our teachers have been meeting weekly to reflect and write a thorough narration that demonstrates how we are meeting the standards. This is arduous but important work. Ultimately accreditation status becomes a statement to the larger community of the School of St. Philip's ongoing commitment to excellence.



A Note from Fr. Jeff Horejsi

After doing some consultation with those who are regulars in praying before the Blessed Sacrament during Eucharistic Adoration twice a month at St. Philip's, I want to announce some changes for the first and third Tuesdays of the month. First, we will be moving Mass from 8:30 am to 5:30 pm with the hope that some who are working full-time might be able to attend. We will begin Eucharistic Adoration at 8:30 am. We will offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation at 4:00—5:00 pm and then Benediction at 5:15 pm. We will try this for a few months to see how it works.

We will be celebrating the Anointing of the Sick as an Area Faith Community Friday, November 16 at St. Philip's at 9:30 am. Anointing will also be offered at the Nov. 8th 9:00 am Bethany and 10:00 am Meeker Manor Masses. If you need to be anointed but cannot come to these Masses, please contact me or Fr. Brian to ask for this sacrament of healing.

Each November each registered member of every parish receives a mailing from the Diocese of New Ulm regarding the Diocesan Ministries Appeal (DMA). Since 20% of each dollar given comes back to your parish, we are encouraged to name a parish project for those funds that come back. St. John's has named the Education Center Parking Lot repair; Our Lady's has designated 75% to their Parking Lot fund and 25% to their Youth Fund; St. Philip's will use their funds for Faith Formation.
