Sacrament of Reconciliation

Consecration to the Holy Family



I encourage you to revitalize our parishes by devoting yourselves to the ideal model of familial love set by Jesus, Mary and Joseph. The word consecration literally means "association with the sacred", and as such it requires a much larger commitment than simply reciting a prayer on the feast of the Holy Family, Dec. 28 & 29.

Here are four suggested actions before praying the Consecration prayer.

1. Discuss the importance of the consecration as a family and why you are doing it.
2. Each member of your family is strongly encouraged to receive the sacrament of reconciliation.
3. As a family, intentionally choose something to fast from, something that you would normally do or consume, for at least a week. Fasting helps to discipline our minds and hearts to refrain from secular activities and be more focused on God.
4. Prepare for the commitment you are making. You and your family are consciously choosing to be a beacon of light of God's love through his Church. Please talk about this with your family.

Scrip - Like many Catholic schools, the School of St. Philip takes part in the Scrip program. For those who may be unfamiliar with this program... It allows people to purchase gift cards from local and national retailers that can be used in the same way as a gift card. They are purchased at face value with a small percentage donated to our school by the participating retailers. You will find gift cards for restaurants, department stores (i.e. Walmart), gas, and even online retailers like Amazon. We have a supply on hand, but if you know that you will be making major purchases in the near future, you can plan ahead and place an order. It has also gotten much easier for you to just go online and place an order so the cards or codes can be emailed directly to you for immediate use. 3. Select The Church of St. Philip (the legal name of the organization). All proceeds will be directed to the School.
4. Click the checkbox that states you understand you must always start at <https://smile.amazon.com/>. You cannot use the Amazon App to use Amazon Smile. However, if you use the app and put things in your cart, they are carried over when you go to use the Amazon Smile website.
5. Start shopping as you normally would and 0.5% of your purchase will be directed to our school.
