A Note from Fr. Jeff Horejsi

This week our parishes will take a collection to benefit the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS), a collection approved by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops to be taken every three years. The AMS is the Archdiocese for the Military Services, not of the Military Services. This is an important distinction, because the AMS receives no funding from the U.S. Government or U.S. Military and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment. Instead, it must rely on the generosity of those whose values and priorities align with its mission, programs and services, to meet its costs. Please prayerfully consider a contribution to this special collection to support active-duty military men and women, and their families.

The General Election is this Tuesday. The U.S. bishops' document to help us prepare for voting is Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship. It can be found at www.faithfulcitizenship.org. This past week the 2022 Diocesan Ministries Appeal letter was mailed to all homes in the diocese. This year's theme is, "Renewed in Hope." The DMA offers us an opportunity to do our part to support the ministries that help to build the Church right here in the Diocese of New Ulm--ministries and services that no single parish could provide. Your contributions to the DMA reach individuals and families across the diocese, providing family and crisis counseling, emergency assistance, religious and spiritual formation, and supporting our seminarians. Once again 20% of all donations will come back to your parish for its designated project: St. Philip--youth patio project; St. John--repair South Stained Glass window; Our Lady--Tuition assistance to families sending their children to the School of St. Philip.

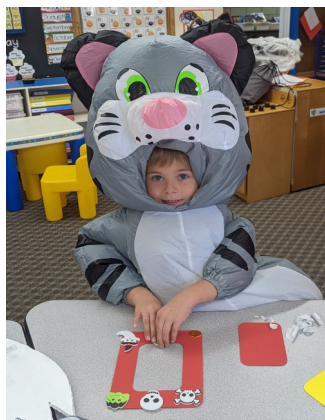
St. John/St. Philip CCW Diaper Drive

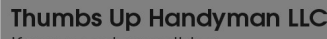
