



Advent is a time of preparing for the coming of the Lord, first at the end of time and then later in the season at Christmas. Please see this bulletin for the Advent Reconciliation schedule which continues Wednesday, Dec. 14th at 6:45pm at Our Lady.

The first postings of the Diocesan Ministries Appeal is out. St. Philip's goal is \$40,137. \$12,283 has been received. St. John's goal is \$15,137. \$3,282 has been received. Our Lady's goal is \$10,779. \$6,003 has been received. If you have not had the opportunity to make your pledge or gift yet, envelopes are available in the back of church. 
Greetings from the School of St. Philip!

YEAR-END GIVING - The end of the year is not far away, and it is time to start thinking of strategies to maximize the tax benefits of year-end giving. Federal tax laws and many state laws make it possible to reduce or eliminate taxes on gifts to charities like your parish, diocese, schools and other ministries. Remember that only gifts made by December 31st can help reduce the amount of taxes you owe next April. Please consult your professional tax advisor for tax strategies for your personal situation. Gifts of Cash- The most popular way to give to charity is still by cash or check. Gifts completed by December 31st will qualify for tax deductibility for the current tax year. Gifts of cash qualify for up to one-half of your adjusted gross income (AGI). You must receive an acknowledgement for gifts of \$250 or more. For more information contact your parish office.

Gifts from Retirement Plans

Retirement plan assets can be a practical source from which to make charitable gifts to your parish. If you are over 70 1/2 and are required to take withdrawals from a Traditional IRA, you may want to consider making a charitable gift using all or a portion of your mandatory withdrawal amount. This way of giving may result in little or no tax impact when you report the amount withdrawn along with an offsetting charitable deduction. For more information contact your parish office.

<u>Scrip Program at the School of St. Philip</u> - It is holiday shopping time, so I thought I would share with a couple of programs that would help out the school while you take care of your shopping needs.

Scrip - Like many Catholic schools, the School of St. Philip takes part in the Scrip program. For those who may be unfamiliar with this program.... It allows people to purchase gift cards from local and national retailers that can be used in the same way as a gift card. They are purchased at face value with a small percentage donated to our school by the participating retailers. You will find gift cards for restaurants, department stores (i.e. Walmart), gas, and even online retailers like Amazon. We have a supply on hand, but if you know that you will be making major purchases in the near future, you can plan ahead and place an order. It has also gotten much easier for you to just go online and place an order so the cards or codes can be emailed directly to you for immediate use. Our school website has tutorial videos to show you how to take part as well as all the links you'll need. Just visit schoolofstphilip.org/scrip. Amazon Smile: - We have also begun using the Amazon Smile program for those who frequent Amazon. Here is a step-by-step guide to get signed up.

- 1. Go to https://smile.amazon.com/ and login to your Amazon account.
- 2. Search zip code 55355
- 3. Select The Church of St. Philip (the legal name of the organization). All proceeds will be directed to the School.
- 4. Click the checkbox that states you understand you must always start at https://smile.amazon.com/. You cannot use the Amazon App to use Amazon Smile. However, if you use the app and put things in your cart, they are carried over when you go to use the Amazon Smile website.
- 5. Start shopping as you normally would and 0.5% of your purchase will be directed to our school.


