A Note from Fr. Jeff Horejsi

Primary Election is August 9th. St. Philip's Church Hall is again the location for Litchfield residents.(Wards 1-5) the voting opens at 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Voting entirely by mail ballots in State and Federal elections: Cedar Mills City, Cosmos City, Kingston City, Cedar Mills Township, Cosmos Township, Danielson Township, Darwin Township, Ellsworth Township, Forest City Township, and Harvey Township.

Redistributing - In 2022 the Congressional Legislative and County Commissioner district boundaries for Meeker County have been reestablished for 2022 and future elections. Meeker County is represented by Congressional District #7. Meeker County is now represented by multiple legislative districts (16 A, 17A, and 29 A.)

In the primary election one must decide on candidates within a designated party. They may not choose a candidate from another political party in a primary election. They must stay within that party choices for each political office.

What is Council of Catholic Women (CCW)

CCW was founded at the request of our U.S. Bishops in 1920. They wanted to unite the efforts of Catholic Women and be a voice for them in the church and world. CCW was founded at a meeting of Catholic Women convened by the U.S. Bishops who had witnessed the important work done by Catholic women's organizations during WW1.

The goals of the Council were established at the first meeting:

- * To give Catholic women of the country a common voice and an instrument for united actions.
- * To ensure proper Catholic representation to national committees and movements.
- * To stimulate the work of existing Catholic organizations to greater service in meeting the needs of the times.

RCIA - The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is the process by which our Church prepares adults for Baptism and the other Sacraments of Initiation - Confirmation and Holy Communion. Their journey begins with reviewing basics of the Catholic Faith, then continues as they grow closer in relationship to God and grow into becoming faithful followers of Jesus in the Catholic Church. The process is more intense during Lent as the candidates prepare for receiving the sacraments at the Easter Vigil. After Easter, we continue to meet and talk about living out our faith. Something to Watch: Saint Ignatius of Loyola: Soldier for Christ

At the end of this week, we celebrate the feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the "Soldier for Christ." While Martin Luther's interior troubles plunged Europe into a maelstrom of controversy, Ignatius of Loyola set out on an extraordinary interior pilgrimage of grace. Taught directly by God, Ignatius offered the Church a new spirituality of devoted service to Christ and founded a religious order dedicated to evangelization, the Jesuits.

Something to Learn: A Bible Study on the Luminous Mysteries: The Transfiguration

This week we celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration, the mountaintop manifestation of Christ's glory that we read about in the Gospel. As we recall this wondrous event, however, many questions might come to mind. Why did Moses and Elijah appear? Why did Jesus only bring Peter, James, and John? Hear the answers to these questions and more in this episode of FORMED Now.

Something to Listen to: Luminous Mysteries

The Transfiguration is part of the Luminous Mysteries, which were introduced to the Church in 2002 by St. John Paul II. These mysteries recall events that demonstrate the light of Christ during his public ministry. 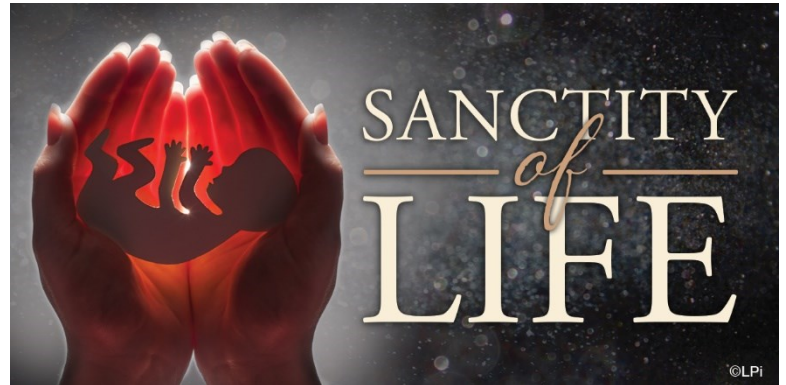
