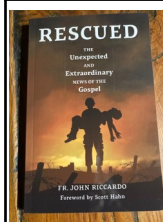
Training for Lectors & Eucharistic Minister -

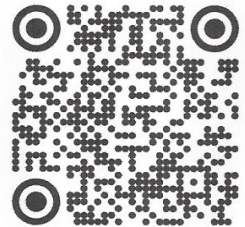
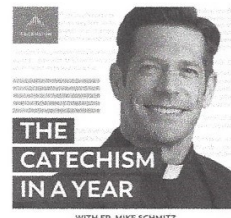
