

A Message From Father Aaron



"I am the resurrection and the life."

Dear Friends,

In this 5th Week of Lent, as Palm Sunday comes next weekend, we hear the great story of the raising of Lazarus in the Gospel of John. Jesus encounters Martha, Mary and the others in a time of great

grief and confusion over the death of Lazarus. These emotions are something that people can relate well with when grieving the loss of a loved one. Martha responds to Jesus that she knows Lazarus will rise in the resurrection on the last day. Then Jesus says, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25-26)

Jesus wants us to realize that the resurrection isn't just something to be hoped for in the future life, but through the Holy Spirit, is in part, experienced here on this earth through a real and living encounter with him. Pope Benedict XVI once said, "Thus Jesus himself is what we call "heaven"; heaven is not a place but a person, the person of him in whom God and man are forever and inseparably one." Brothers and sisters, may we continue to strive this Lent, in all we do, to draw closer to Jesus Christ, who is the resurrection and the life.

*I would like to give a great word of thanks to all who participated in, and all who helped with our parish mission, "Disciples on Mission" with Father Boniface Hicks and Kristin Molitor. It was a wonderful turn out of people and some very spirit-filled encounters were had during the talks and times of Adoration, Confession and Holy Mass.
