

Saint Report

1st year Confirmation candidates are asked to do research on saints and find one that they admire and/or look to for inspiration. This saint will become their chosen Saint for their Confirmation Name. Candidates are asked to type at least a one-page, double spaced report about the Saint. The report may include things like:

- **A brief summary on the life of the Saint.**
- **Why did you decide to choose this Saint?**
- **Does the Saint play a significance in your life right now?**
- **Why was the Saint holy?**
- **Why were they canonized a Saint?**
- **What do you have in common or hope to have in common with the Saint?**

10th grade candidates must complete and submit their Saint Reports by Mar. 31st.

If a candidate decides to use their own given name as their Confirmation name, they must still research a saint and write a report. The paper can be scanned and e-mailed to nstewart@shepherdofsouls.org or mailed or hand-delivered to the Faith Formation Office.
