



Good Shepherd Fall Festival Activities Are Coming

We are working hard to bring you some of the most popular fundraising activities associated with our Fall Festival. These are opportunities for you to support our Parish. We have 2 more parts of our traditional Festival for you:

Fall Festival Carry-Out Dinner & Food Sale

- **When:** Sunday, November 8th
- **Time:** 12:00 – 3:00 pm
- **Where:** St. James site
- **Meal:** Chicken, mashed potatoes w/ gravy, dressing w/gravy, coleslaw, cranberries, dessert
- **Cost:** \$12.00 adult, \$5.00 children 5 and under
- **Other items for sale:**
 - Haas sauerkraut: \$3.00/quart
 - Sinsinawa Mound Bakery:
 - Cinnamon Bread: \$9.00
 - 12 Caramel Rolls: \$10.00
 - 6 Dinner Rolls: \$7.00
 - Pfeffernusse cookies: \$5.00/bag
 - Since we don't know how many bags will be available, these will not be a pre-order. There will be a table for them next to the cashier table. Bring extra cash or check.
- **All items must be pre-ordered so we can ensure the appropriate amount of food. Pre-ordering will end at 9:00 pm on Sunday, October 25.**

Two ways to order:

- *On-line at Givesmart (preferred)*
 - Go to GSPSA20.givesmart.com
 - You must use a credit or debit card to register and establish an account first, but they will not use the card unless we enter a charge.
 - **On the auction page, go to the ITEMS Tab at the top of the screen and find the items you want to order and buy the number you want.**
 - When you come to pick up your food, we recommend you pay by cash or check to save a 3.5% credit card charge, or you can ask to have the order charged on GiveSmart.
 - Items ordered but not picked up will be charged to you on Givesmart (including the 3.5% fee).
- *For those with no computer access, you can pre-order using the forms in the back of the church.*
 - Fill out the form and attach cash or a check for the amount you order.

- If you choose to order with the paper form, bring the form and the money back to church and hand them to the usher. Or drop the form at the Rectory, the School, or Denice's office at St Joseph. We must have all orders by **Sunday, October 25.**

Fall Festival Silent Auction

We are using the **Givesmart** platform to auction off some wonderful items such as food, toys, jewelry and more! The most exciting item is a 7-Course Italian Dinner for eight prepared by our own Italian chef, Fr. Dave Carrano! Stony has also donated some great wood items again this year.

The on-line Silent Auction will start at 8:00 am on Saturday, October 24 and will end promptly at 9:00 pm on Sunday, November 8.

- If you have registered to order Fall Festival dinners online, you can preview now and bid starting on Oct. 24 on ITEMS in the Silent Auction. If you have not already registered, you can register and preview the items before you place a bid. This is a good idea, so you can plan ahead for your bidding on the Silent Auction items.
- Go to GSPSA20.givesmart.com to buy food or bid on auction items. Go to the ITEMS tab at the top of the screen and browse.
- Check back often in case we get new items during the two-week auction.
- Bids will be accepted right up to the 9:00 pm deadline, so follow closely items that you really want. You will know immediately at the end of the auction if you won the items you have bid on by checking on the Givesmart site.
- All items must be picked up at St. James School front entrance on Tuesday, November 10, 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm.
- You can pay at that time with cash or check. Or if you prefer to have your items charged on Givesmart, there will be a 3.5% service fee added to your total purchase.
