Attention All Married and Engaged Couples:

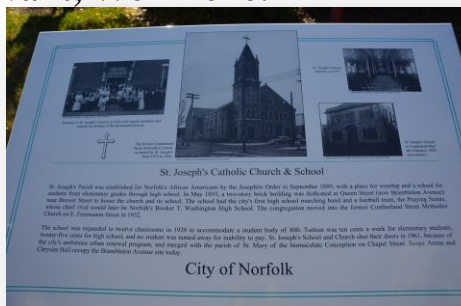
