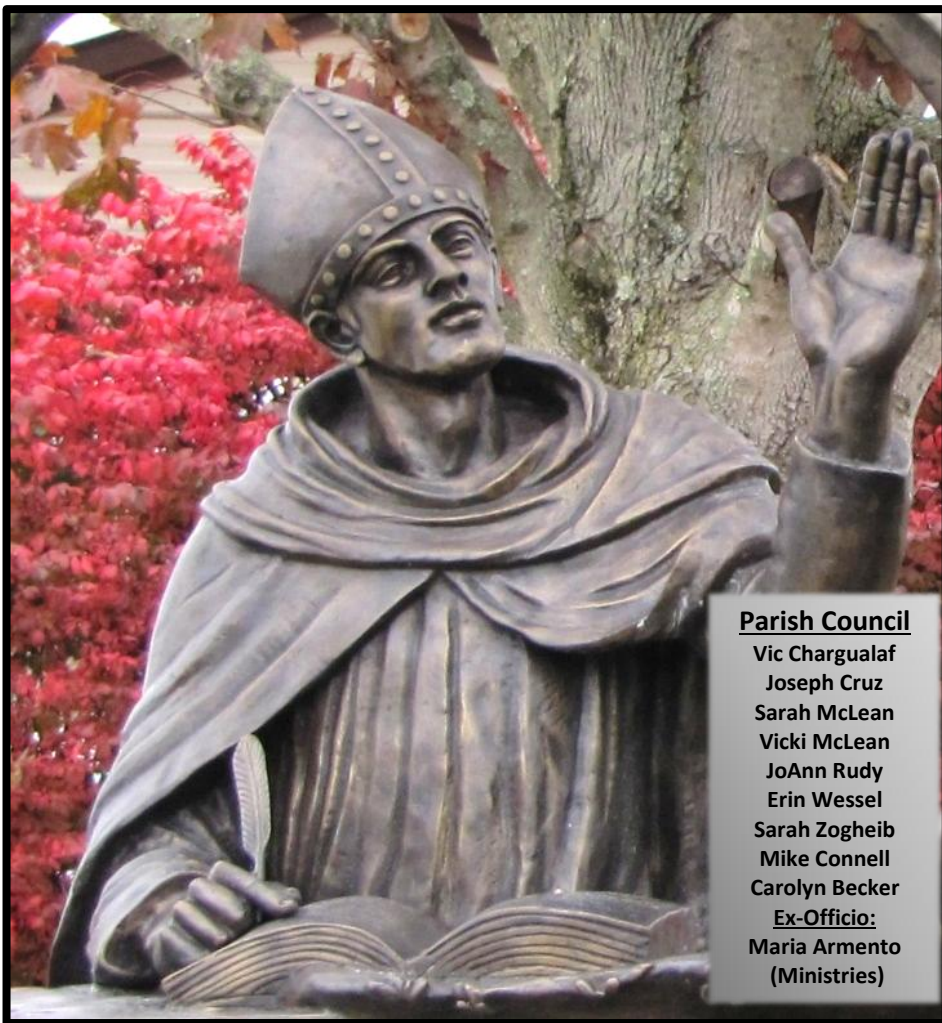



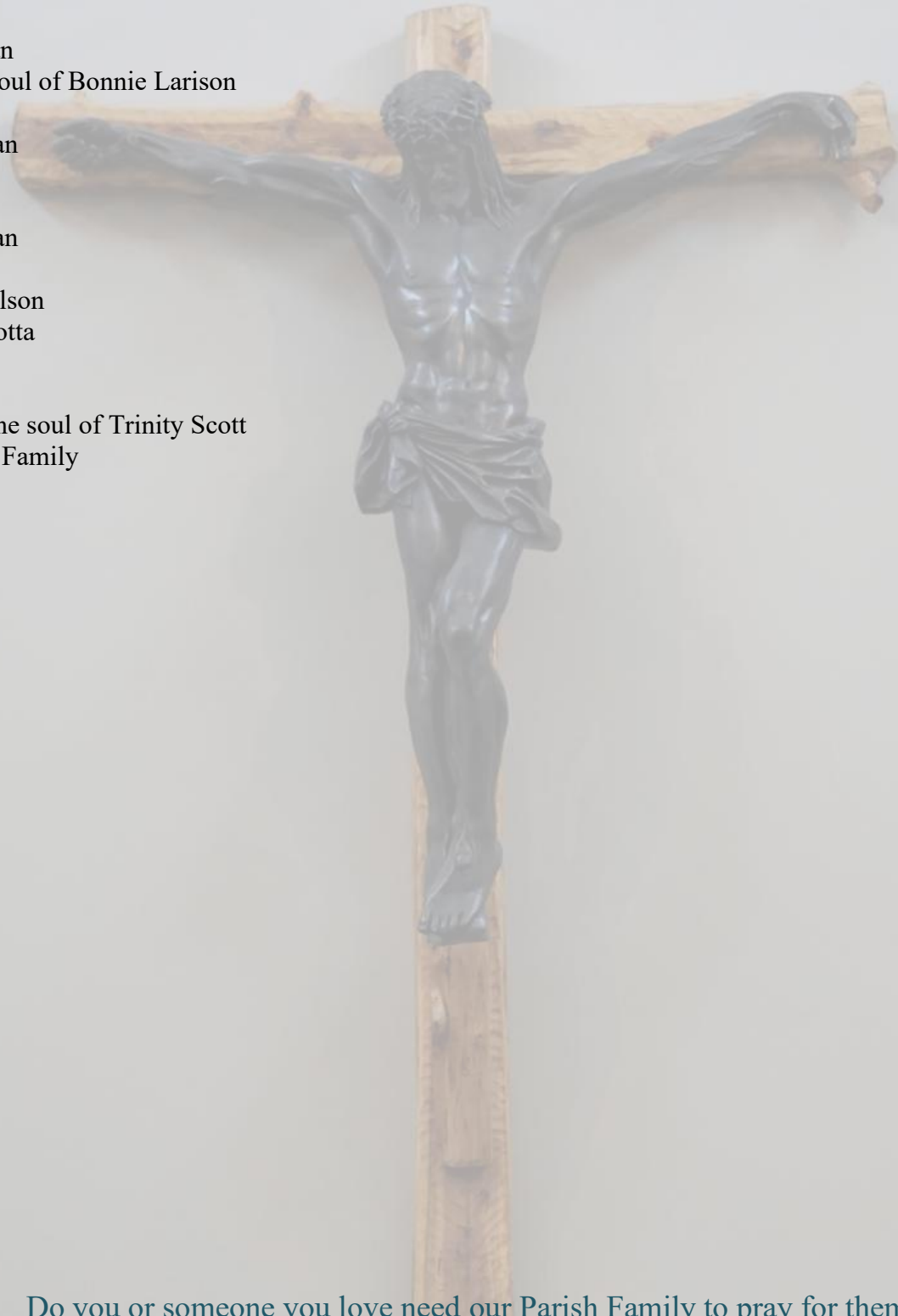
**All budget numbers are budgeted evenly through the year except for property insurance, Christmas Collection, and Adult Social.*
