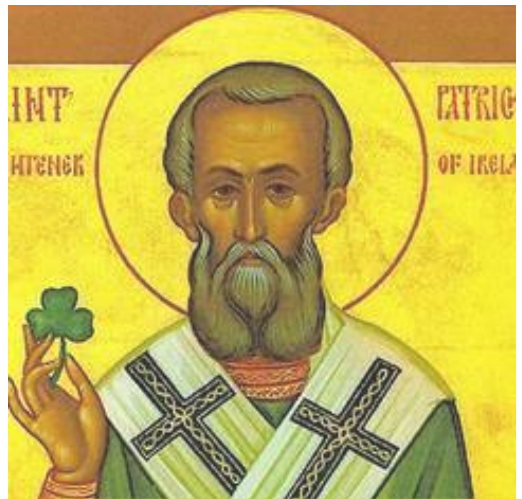

Starting on Holy Thursday, we will have Eucharistic Adoration open to the Parish in our new Adoration Chapel.

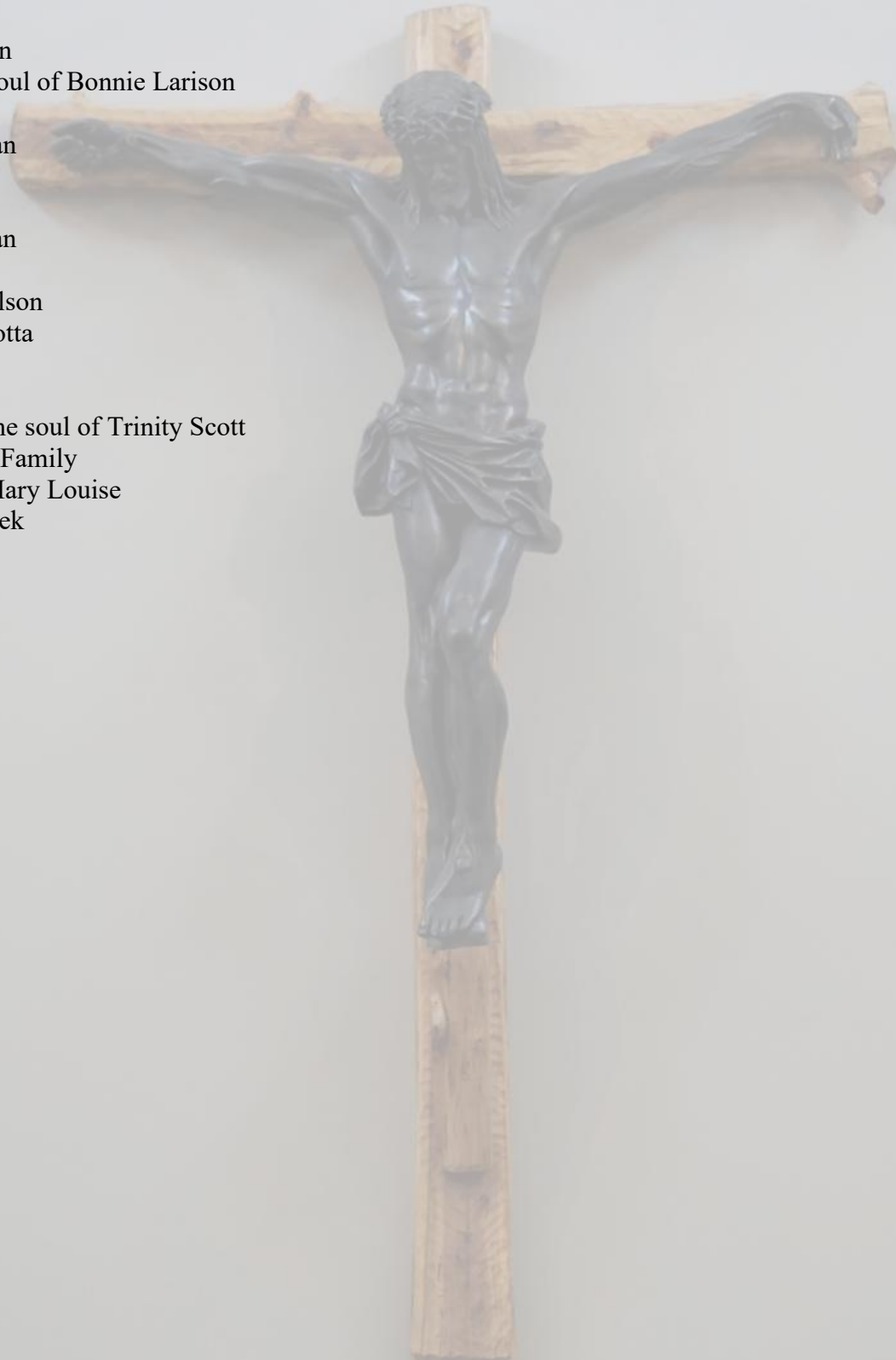
