Notice of Class Cancellation

(approved by Faith Formation Commission; effective September 1, 2014)

Attendance Policy: Attendance is required at all Faith Formation classes. We want to make sure ALL students are accounted for, so it is important to please call your Site Supervisor when your child/children will be absent.

Weather: If schools are canceled or let out early due to weather, FF classes will be canceled as well. Should bad weather occur during the intermediate time, notification will be sent using GroupMe. Use your parental discretion as well in determining whether you want to drive or have your child drive in questionable weather.

Sports and other Extracurricular Activities: Because our Prince of Peace Cluster involves multiple school districts, there will be no cancellation of FF classes because of sports and other extracurricular activities. Per the attendance policy above, call your Site Supervisor if you know your child will be absent.

Disciplinary Procedure Policy

A disturbance needing a student disciplinary procedure includes, and not limited to, those actions of disruptive behavior, disrespect, disobedience, misuse of property, and anything else that causes total disruption of class.

First Disturbance: Meeting with catechist, student, site supervisor, and parents.

Second Disturbance: Meeting with catechist, student, site supervisor, parents, and CRE. At this time, parents are required to attend the classes each week.

Third Disturbance: Meeting with catechist, student, site supervisor, parents, CRE, and pastor.

If a resolution cannot be found after meeting with the pastor, the student is expelled for the remainder of the Faith Formation school year. If the student requests re-admittance to the program, the student and parents need to meet with the Faith Formation Commission. The Faith Formation Commission supports this policy.

Attendance: Attendance is required and tracked at all Faith Formation classes. It is our goal for students to receive at least 30 hours of Faith Formation throughout the Faith Formation Year. This would be accomplished by having 24 - 1.25 hr classes. We recognize that life can throw unexpected things at us, and we want to give ample opportunities for students to authentically grow in their Catholic Faith. Our program is offering 28 formation opportunities throughout the year in hopes that all of our students can meet or exceed the 30 hour goal. To help us plan for absences appropriately, please call your Site Supervisor or Catechist to let First Wednesday Family Nights: Both the St. Paul and Sacred Heart them know your child will be absent.

Drop Off- Pick Up: This is an updated policy for the 24-25 School year now included for the safety and well-being of all of our students. Due to the timing of our classes and the busy nature of our parking lot, we are asking all parents of students 1st-3rd Grade to come to the door to pick up their child vs. having them find your vehicle in the parking lot. This is especially important when our classes end and it is dark outside.

Church/Rectory Entrance for Classes: For the safety of our children, we will only have one door unlocked for entrance and exiting of our class buildings on Faith Formation night. At St. Pauls, this will be the back door on the west side of the church. At Sacred Heart, this will be the front door on the north side of the Rectory for 1st-6th Grade Classrooms, and the main entrance of the Church for 7/8th and DWELL Classrooms. This includes First Wednesday Family nights.

Communication: Faith Formation Program Schedule will be able to be found on the Prince of Peace Website, and other communication will be done through bulletin updates and the GroupMe App depending on the urgency of the message. GroupMe will be used to share weekly reminders to parents, last minute communications, or other necessary notes. All online registrants should have been invited to participate in the "Prince of Peace Faith Formation" Group on GroupMe. If you did not receive an invite and would like to receive updates through this communication tool, please contact the CRE.

We will be using Facebook for sharing recaps of events and special activities, but will be moving away from this as a reminder/notification tool. Email will also be used for class cancellation, weather updates, or other forward planning/communication.

To follow special Facebook posts, search "Sacred Heart Faith Formation" or "St. Paul Faith Formation" and request to be added to the group. An admin will approve your request and you will be granted access to the page.

Parishes will be hosting monthly opportunities for families to gather with their children to learn more about our faith together. On the first Wednesday of each month, families are invited to join their student in the parish Chapel at 7:15 PM for a 30 minute lesson and activity that helps build understanding of various faith related topics.
