STEWARDSHIP SPOT: Like the sensible bridesmaids in today’s parable, good stewards makes sure that they, and whatever gifts are theirs to share, are ready to serve when the Master calls.

Memorial Trees during Christmas Time: trees in the entryway will be ornamented in memory of deceased family members and/or friends. On each ornament: the deceased person’s name (as you specify) and their dates of birth and death. Donation is **\$5/ornament; funds go to the Major Capital Fund**. Please place your donation (and proper info) in the Sun. collection basket in an envelope, call/e-mail Joan, or bring (M-F, 8A-5P) to the parish church office **no later than Fri., Dec. 12**. Please note: you do not need to pay again for ornaments paid for and displayed on these memorial trees in previous years.

~ *Limited Public Masses* ~

We began “limited public Masses” in June with guidelines limiting the number of attendees per Mass; **we are now able to accommodate 78 people for any limited public Mass**. Since this is the case, we no longer need to limit weekday Masses (Mon. – Thurs., Sat. mornings), but still need to limit Sunday Masses. **You/your household are now able to attend any number of Sunday Masses per month** (and please use the EventBrite system to register for Sunday Masses); also, you are more than welcome to **attend weekday Masses as well** (and no longer need to register via EventBrite to attend weekday Masses). Please see the notes below for instructions when attending these limited public Masses (on any day of the week):

General Notes (for “Limited Public Masses”, i.e., “these Masses”):

- Catholics (in the Diocese of Rapid City) remain dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass
 - However, Catholics are encouraged to attend these Masses throughout the week, if/when possible

Guidelines for attending these Masses with a limited number of people:

- If you have face mask, you are encouraged (but not required) to wear it
 - If you don’t have one, some will be available at the church building
- Please wash your hands before leaving home
 - Sanitizer will also be available at the church building
- You/your household will be checked-in at the exterior door of the church building
- Upon entering the church building, maintain six (6) feet of distance between yourself/your household and others
- Please be seated (by an usher) in designated pews and maintain proper distancing

Adjustments to these Masses include:

- A collection basket will be located near the entrance to the worship space
- Communion will be distributed in a single-file line with proper distancing; other directions may be given
 - Receiving Communion in the hand is encouraged; if receiving on the tongue, please wait until all others receive

Other Notes:

- Please maintain six (6) feet of distance when socializing/visiting after Mass (and do so outside the worship space, please)
- Pews where people were seated during these Masses will be sanitized following Mass
- Please wash your hands when you return home
