### ~ Limited Public Masses ~

Please see the notes below for instructions when attending these limited public Masses (on any day of the week):

**General Notes (for “Limited Public Masses”, i.e., “these Masses”):**

- Catholics (in the Diocese of Rapid City) are obliged to attend Sunday Mass

**Guidelines for attending these Masses with a limited number of people:**

- If you have face mask, you are encouraged to wear it
  - If you don't have one, some will be available
- Please wash your hands before leaving home
  - Sanitizer will also be available at the church building
- Upon entering the church building, maintain six (6) feet of distance between yourself/your household and others
- Please be seated in designated pews and maintain proper distancing

**Adjustments to these Masses include:**

- A collection basket will be located near the entrance to the worship space
- Communion will be distributed in a single-file line with proper distancing; other directions may be given
  - Receiving Communion in the hand is encouraged; if receiving on the tongue, please wait until all others receive

**Other Notes:**

- Please maintain six (6) feet of distance when socializing/visiting after Mass (and do so outside the worship space, please)
- Pews where people were seated during these Masses will be sanitized following Mass
- Please wash your hands when you return home
