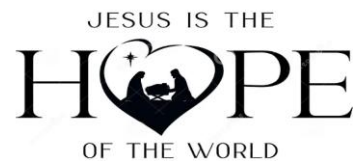

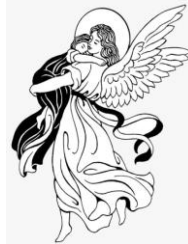

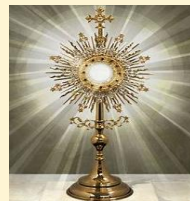
Father Collins celebrates Mass for our Residents at each

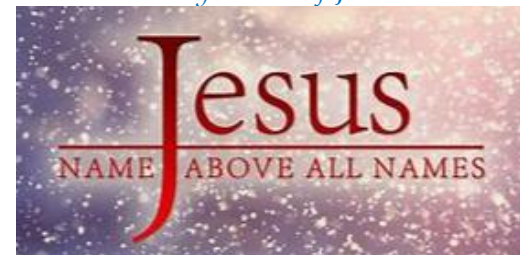
