Tidbits of Faith:

A Doctor of the Church is a saint recognized by the
Catholic Church for their significant contributions
to theology and doctrine, which have greatly
influenced Catholic thought. To earn this title, a
saint's teachings must be theologically sound and
beneficial to the Church. The term "Doctor" comes
from the Latin word "docere", meaning "to teach,"
highlighting their role as eminent teachers of the
faith. As of 2025, there are 38 recognized Doctors
of the Church, each having made profound
contributions to spiritual, intellectual, or moral
dimensions of the faith.

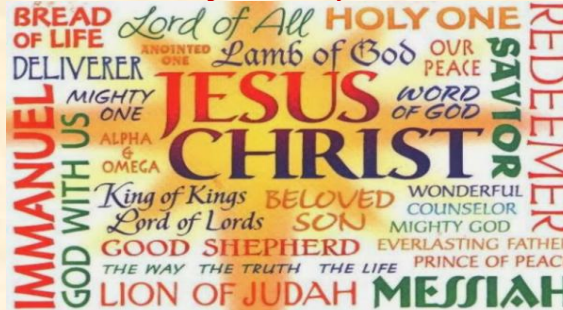

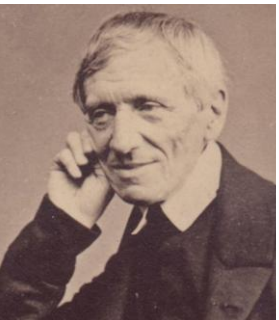
Our parish pledge was set at \$11,660.
