GEORGE WEIGEL ~ KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Catholic Social Services (CSS) will host its **Annual Palm Sun. Brunch** on **Sun., April 14, NOON-2P**, in the Ballrooms at the Ramkota Hotel in Rapid City.

George Weigel, Distinguished Senior Fellow of Ethics at the Public Policy Center, is a Catholic Theologian and one of America's leading public intellectuals. He holds EPPC's William E. Simon Chair in Catholic Studies. He is perhaps best known for his widely translated and internationally acclaimed two-volume biography of Pope St. Paul II, a New York Times bestseller, *Witness of Hope* (1999) and its sequel, *The End and Beginning* (2010). In 2017 Weigel published a memoir of the experiences that led to his papal biography: *Lessons in Hope – My Unexpected Life with St. John Paul II*. He is the author of more than 20 other books, including *The Cube* and *The Cathedral: Europe, America and Politics without God* (2005). Mr. Weigel's column also appears semi-monthly in the *West River Catholic*, the official publication of the Diocese of Rapid City.
