C) Commission Updates

- Worship – John (HT), Reiny (SM)
 - St. Michaels
 - Prayer Service on 5/6/24 at 7pm
 - Blessing of Vehicles
 - Holy Trinity
 - Move the vigil lights in front of church
 - Encouraged to take time in front of the Blessed Sacrament even if for a short time
- Formation – Tina (SM)
- Human Concerns – Marea (HT)
 - Marea stepping down from Pastoral Council due to family health concerns
 - Jackie will attend the next Human Concerns meeting
- Stewardship – Jan (SM)
 - Planning a sign up for hospitality jobs to allow a break to those continually performing these tasks
 - Idea to have a mum plant fundraiser - \$20 / plant
- School – Rhiannon (SM)
 - \$1,400 made from the Chili Lunch (45 To-Go's & 175 Dine-In's)
 - HT School featured twice in the Kewaskum Statesman and the Catholic Herald
 - Pancake Breakfast sold 79 tickets so far

 - Thoughts of adding new flashing to the cupola OR removing it and sealing / shingling over the top – No pricing yet
 - Paving the back parking lot quotes are up to \$70K
- HT Building & Grounds – Kevin
 - Door Stain Color – Committee wants dark walnut vs golden oak. Samples will be made prior to making decision.

- Faith Formation – New curriculum (Spirit and Truth). Program will be introduced next year. The new program is more cost effective and offers more continuity. Activities in Edge will remain.
- Met with the principal of the middle school and superintendent - Starting next school year, HT School students will have access to extracurricular programs that are not available at HT School
- Working on creating a master plan/budget for both Building & Grounds committees
- Fr. will begin saying mass and offering RCIA opportunities for those interested at Kettle Moraine Correctional Institution
- Eucharistic Revival – a “Marian Year” will be our focus for next year
