

## **BUILDING COMMITTEE ACTIVITY**

In April and May the St Matthew Building and Stewardship Sub-Committees of the Administrative Council met to discuss with a structural engineer and an architect about taking our next step in the second phase of the 2011 St Matthew Master Plan, seismically upgrading the structure of the school roof while replacing the protective roofing layer.

Those who have visited the school during the rainy season, know of the buckets collecting rainwater in the north end of the upper hallway. To address the need for the new roof, the Admin Council has committed to spend \$25K in unused, unrestricted capital campaign funds to commission the engineer and architect to produce the requisite specs for both the seismic upgrading of the school roof and its replacement.

Timing would target the summer of 2020, after the children are out of school for 2-1/2 months. As developments progress, your Stewardship Sub-Committee will continue to keep parishioners apprised.
