THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY is a Holy Day of Obligation. The Immaculate Mother of God was conceived without sin and was not capable of committing sin. Having completed the course of her earthly life, she was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory [Pius XII, [Munificentissimus Deus](#) 44]. This teaching was infallibly defined by Pope Pius XII on Nov. 1, 1950. As Pius XII explained, this is “a divinely revealed dogma” (ibid.). It is thus a matter of faith that has been divinely revealed by God and that has been infallibly proposed by the Magisterium of the Church as such. Since it is a dogma defined by the pope (rather than by an ecumenical council, for example), it is also an “ex cathedra” statement (one delivered “from the chair” of Peter).
