THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. The Holy Trinity is one of the greatest mysteries of the Catholic faith, and is an attempt to describe the mysterious nature of God. The Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church explains it this way: The Church expresses her trinitarian faith by professing a belief in the oneness of God in whom there are three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The three divine Persons are only one God because each of them equally possesses the fullness of the one and indivisible divine nature. They are really distinct from each other by reason of the relations which place them in correspondence to each other. The Father generates the Son; the Son is generated by the Father; the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son (CCC 48), (CCC 249-256, 266).


