### **Lenten Regulations:**

**Fasting:** this is eating one normal sized meal, with 2 partial meals that do not equal a full meal with no snacking between. Catholics are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. (ages 18-59)

**Abstaining from meat:** Catholic are required to abstain from meat and anything made from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. (ages 13 and up).

**Finish Lent well,** consider attending a daily mass, stations of the Cross, make a Holy Hour, Plan to attend the upcoming parish mission, take the time to receive the sacrament of confession, plan to celebrate Holy Week (Holy Thursday, Good Friday & Easter Vigil)....challenge yourself to “Have a Miserable Lent” but also be renewed in God’s Grace and presence.
