Healing Mass:

Sunday, December 6th, 2020 at 4:00 pm St. Patrick Church, McCook
3:30 pm will be The Divine Mercy Chaplet

The greatest form of healing prayer is the Mass, during which Christ, the Physician of souls and bodies, comes to His people and touches them, releasing His healing love and power in their lives. While every Mass is a “healing” Mass, an encounter with the divine Physician, sometimes a priest chooses to have a Mass offered specifically for the intention of healing.

Out of faith in Christ’s word, “If two of you agree upon earth about anything you shall ask for, it shall be given to you by my Father in Heaven” (Mt 18:19), Fr. Chris Barak from Lincoln is coming to McCook to have a Healing Mass. He asked that any of us that could do prayers prior to the healing Mass would be very beneficial. The prayer team is asked to fast in order to sacrifice so that others might receive healing. Scripture reminds us of the many benefits of fasting. It supports both the health of our body and our spiritual strength. Only when we are freed of continuous feeding do we discover the quiet strength of trusting in God for our next feast. The prayer team’s sacrifices are needed. Team members are especially encouraged to offer up their sacrifices so that they and others might experience: 1) an increase in faith 2) the grace to forgive 3) healing 4) deliverance.

The following are the Prayer and Fasting Commitments of the Prayer Team:

- 1) Pray rosary daily for the Healing Mass starting on Nov. 6th – Dec. 6th
- 2) 11 days before Healing Mass-Novena to the Immaculate Heart of Mary (begin Nov. 25th- Dec. 5th)
- 3) Fast will be for nine days same as our Novena Nov. 25th- Dec. 5th with no fasting on Thanksgiving Day and Sunday Nov. 29th. One full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. (If you fast according to the way you feel God is calling you to the graces will be abundant!)

If, due to medical necessity, you must lessen the fasting commitments, please do what you can. Substitutions can be anything that is a sacrifice for you. Something you have trouble doing with- out such as TV and other electronic devices, idle talking, etc.

On the back you will find the Novena Prayer to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, which will begin on Nov. 25th. Thank you for your prayers and sacrifice on behalf of God’s people. May God grant us the graces to fully love and serve Him!
